Notice is hereby given that the Village of Lannon will hold a public hearing on Thursday, November 5, 2020 starting at 5:30 p.m. in the municipal garage located at Village Hall.

The public hearing will be held to gather public input on the proposed 2020 Water Impact Fee Update Study prepared by Strand Associates, Inc. dated October 2020 which is on file and available to the public at the Village Clerk's office in anticipation of this public hearing.

There will be discussion and possible immediate action after the public hearing by the Village Board on approving the study and approval of an Impact Fee Ordinance amendment addressing local water main extensions, transmission main oversizing, storage and supply facilities that have been installed or are required as detailed in the 2020 Water Impact Fee Update Study prepared by Strand Associates, Inc. dated October 2020 and to amend the water impact fee ordinance to base the calculation of a Residential Equivalent Connection (REC) for non-residential water users on water meter size as detailed in the 2020 Water Impact Fee Update Study prepared by Strand Associates, Inc. dated October 2020.

Written comments on the proposed actions should be submitted before the public hearing date to the Village Clerk. All written comments will be forwarded to the Village of Lannon Village Board.
