

**VILLAGE OF LANNON**  
**MINUTES FROM THE SPECIAL VILLAGE BOARD MEETING FROM 7/21/21**

1. Call to order by presiding officer. President Sommers called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.  
President Sommers stated he was sorry for the comments and stated it won't happen again.
3. Roll Call: Barbieri, Jensen, Martin, Nellis, Reek, Sommers and Yates were present.
4. Statement of Public Notice was confirmed.
5. Citizens Comments:

Trustee Yates read comments from Colleen Lake – 6802 N. Townline Rd., Corey Evinrude-21790F N Weather Edge Circle, and Jessie Schmidt.
