MEMO: Monthly Activity – July, 2024

Date: August 1st, 2024

July 1st, 10:17 PM: Dispute, 21000 block W. Main St. Caller states his mother-in-law is refusing to return his car. There is a 72-hour no contact order in place preventing him from going there to get it. He was advised to wait until the following day.

1st, 11:49 PM: Animal complaint (coyotes), Lannon Estates.

2nd, 10:30 AM: Flock alert, Appleton & Good Hope. Flock cameras detected a stolen car westbound from that location, it did not make it into the village. Unable to locate.

2nd, 2:00 PM: Well-being check, Lannon Estates. Resident, who has not been seen in some time, was found to be OK.

3rd, 5:45 PM: Suspicious, Rock Pointe Apartments. Resident believes children in the adjacent apartment are spying on her through the vents. No evidence of same, referred to management.

4th, 2:30 PM: Traffic stop, 20300 block W. Lannon Rd. A moped, stopped for a registration violation, was found to have been stolen in 2020. Vehicle was towed, juvenile riders were released to their parents.

6th, 4:48 PM: Well-being check, Rock Pointe Apartments. Woman who appeared to have psychiatric issues was roaming the grounds for an extended period. She was found to be safe and returned home.

7th, 6:38 PM: Threats, 21000 block W. Main St. Estranged father of resident's children made threats to harm the family. Report filed.

8th, 8:30 AM: Accident (hit and run to mailbox, signpost), 7100 block N. Lannon Rd. Resident reports seeing a dark colored pickup truck dragging her mailbox at about 1:00 AM. The vehicle then entered the Lannon Elementary School parking lot where it struck two more signs.

8th, 11:00 AM: Weapon violation, Overstone Condos. Resident reported a man with a BB gun shooting at geese in the pond. The suspect was located and was issued a citation for discharging an air gun in the village. The DNR was notified and declined to issue further citations.

8th, 8:35 PM: Menomonee Falls PD located the subject and vehicle wanted for the threat complaint from the 7th. Lt. Lang noticed the vehicle matched the description of the one wanted for the numerous hit and run incidents to mailboxes and signs in the area. Lt. Lang responded to the vehicle's location and matched the piece of trim left at a hit and run scene to the vehicle. Numerous hit and run citations were issued to the driver in addition to being arrested for the threats.

9th, 12:00 PM: 911 no cause, Circle Drive.

9th, 6:47 PM: Accident (property damage only), Townline & Main.

10th, 4:55 AM: Psychiatric crisis, Lannon BP. A woman with psychiatric issues walked to several gas stations in the area and called police asking for a ride from each one. She was eventually picked up by family members.

10th, 7:40 AM: 911 no cause, E. Stone Ridge Drive.

10th, 10:10 AM: 911 no cause, Whispering Ridge.

11th, 12:30 PM: Assist other agency (WSD), Waukesha Memorial Hospital. Chief Bell performed a DRE evaluation on their arrestee.

12th, 9:00 AM: Suspicious, Laron Rd. An occupied truck was parked blocking the gate for an extended period. The occupant was contracted by WE Energies and was doing work.

18th, 3:50 PM: Well-being check, 7100 block N. Lannon Rd. Complainant from the UK alleges that a Lannon resident is often intoxicated and abuses her children. The complainant made several such allegations over the course of several days via

phone to our department and via INTERPOL. The complaint was found to be baseless, contact was made with police in the UK to warn the caller to stop calling.

18th, 5:04 PM: Drug complaint, 7200 block N. Lannon Rd. Rooming house resident reports neighbor is smoking marijuana. The neighbor, who consumed all the marijuana, was warned future infractions would result in citations being issued.
