Date: September 3rd, 2024

August 1st, 9:00 AM: Fire alarm, St. John's Church. False alarm.

1st, 2:20 PM: Suicide threat, 7200 block N. Lannon Rd. Crisis workers implemented a safety plan.

1st, 8:00 PM: Neighbor dispute, Lannon Estates. The caller reports she feels threatened by the neighbor who has been drunk and made intimidating statements in the past. The caller was encouraged to call when the conduct is occurring.

1st, 8:17 PM: Ambulance call, 19500 block W. Main St.

2nd, 1:30 PM: Theft, Rock Pointe Apartments. The caller reported movers opened and used a gift card that was packed away in a box. Investigation pending.

9th, 4:15 PM: Well-being check, Lannon Estates. Caller reports resident has not been seen in days and dogs are barking. The resident was determined to be at work. HAWS will follow up on the animals' living conditions.

9th, 6:01 PM: Reckless auto, Townline & Good Hope. Unable to locate.

10th, 1:12 PM: Ambulance call, Bugline Trail near Lannon Rd. The woman was leaning against a fence, and it gave way.

10th, 2:48 PM: Reckless auto, Lannon Rd. & Good Hope Rd. The caller reported a back 2-door revving its engine and doing burnouts in the intersection. The vehicle and driver were eventually located on Lake St. where the driver was cited for reckless driving.

19th, 11:15 AM: Suspicious, 19500 block W. Main St. Resident reports he was mowing his lawn when a car pulled up, driver exited and asked resident for money for gas to get to Kenosha. The subject was denied and left without further incident. A check of the area was conducted with negative results.

Caller spoke with officers for over an hour, and Waukesha County Crisis was contacted as well to speak with the caller. The caller was provided resources and a follow-up call by crisis was scheduled. The caller had calmed down and no longer needed police assistance.

29th, 9:52 PM: Landlord/Tenant Trouble, 7300 Lake St. Caller concerned about landlord watching their house.

30th, 12:20 AM: Disorderly Conduct, 20100 W. Good Hope Rd. Verbal argument. The subject refusing to leave, was arrested on warrants.

30th, 5:48 AM: 911 Open Line, 7100 N. Lannon Rd. Unfounded

30th, 8:30 AM: Domestic Violence, 19200 Rock Pointe Way, The Caller reports her girlfriend broke numerous items and punched her prior to leaving the residence. The girlfriend then sent nude photographs of the caller to acquaintances. The case was referred to the Waukesha DA's office for charging.

30th, 11:00 AM: Child Abuse, 19200 Rock Pointe Way, The suspect from the domestic violence call was reporting alleged child abuse against the caller. Case was turned over to CPS.
