MEMO: Monthly Activity – May 2025

Date: June 2nd, 2025

May 1st, 2:22 AM: Suspicious, Lannon Estates. Resident saw someone on his roof. Possible psychiatric issues.

1st, 10:15 AM: Assist other agency (Brookfield PD), Townline & Main. Brookfield was in pursuit of a stolen vehicle in the area, officer responded to deploy spike strips. The vehicle did not enter the village.
