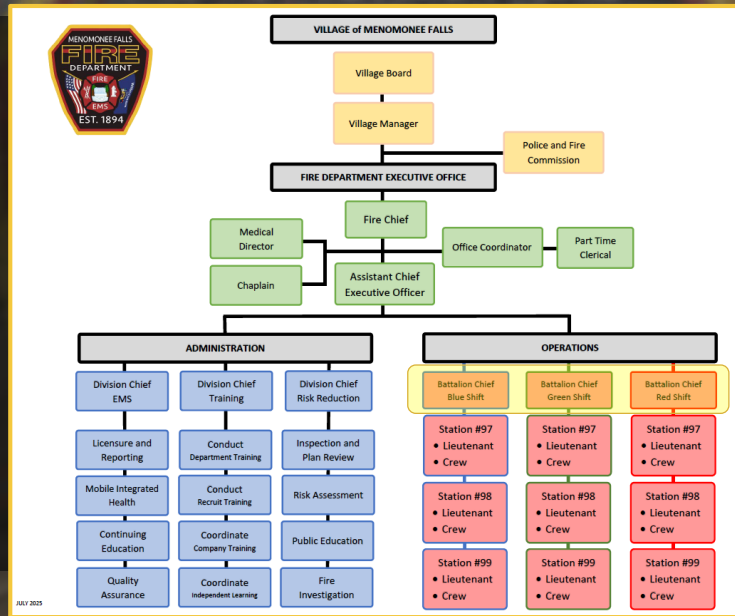

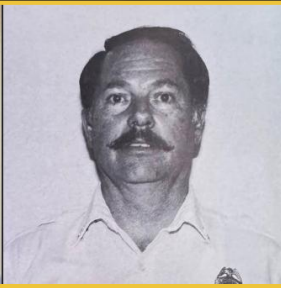


Captain (Ret.) Otto "Fred" Struve
