Cost: \$50 payable by cash or check on the day of attending the course

This course is Wisconsin Department of Justice recognized to fulfill the training requirement for obtaining a Wisconsin Carry Concealed Weapon (CCW) License. After successful completion of this course, you will receive a certificate that qualifies as proof of training to obtain your CCW Permit in the State of Wisconsin. This permit is recognized in 36 states.

You will be taught this course by veteran street cops. You will receive a police perspective regarding the content of this course.

On the day of the course, bring a government-issued photo ID and payment of \$50 (cash or checks only). Attendees do not need to bring a firearm. Firearms will be provided for the in-class safety exercise. **NO AMMUNITION NEEDED OR ALLOWED!!!** We strictly adhere to and demand a safe environment for all participants who attend this training. The instructors will have safety-checked firearms for instructional purposes.
