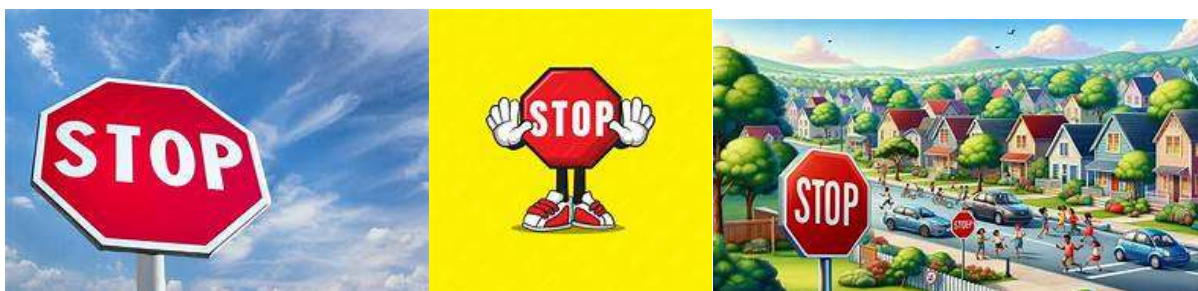
LET'S WORK TOGETHER TO KEEP LANNON SAFE!!
